

**FEED BACK STUDY ON STUDENT TEACHER INTERACTION FOR BATCH
2014 AND BATCH 2015**

Level of teacher-student interaction during theory lectures was ascertained from both the batches. 55(43.65%) students of 2014 batch rated teacher-student interaction >3 on Likert scale, whereas, 76(64.40%) students of 2015 batch rated teacher student interaction >3 on Likert scale. This shows that interaction between students and teachers during the classes is increasing.

The amount of teacher-student interaction could not be quantified but methods like asking questions, brainstorming and buzz groups were used to stimulate and motivate students towards better learning.
